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RUPEE GIFT BY RESIDENT TO NRI INDIVIDUAL





I wish to send Rs. 1,50,000 to her so that she can buy a gift of her choice for her 20th birthday. As per my knowledge, gifts to a relative are non taxable under income tax law. But my sister is an NRI so I wanted to make sure if I am allowed to do this under FEMA also?

Yes Mr Ranjan, Since Ms. Anaysa your relative, you're allowed to gift under FEMA Regulations also. Let me simplify you the conditions that are needed to be fulfilled for the same:







Got it! One more thing, Anaysa is also planning to visit India in the coming days so what if I gift her in cash when she comes? Am I allowed to do so?

Well Mr. Ranjan that's not permitted.. You cannot gift **rupee in cash** to your sister since she is an NRI.
