Yes, I do hold a long-term visa issued by the central government, but what happened why you inquired such thing!

Nothing much! I was just asking as there are different provisions for acquisition of Immovable property by the citizens of Afghanistan, Bangladesh and Pakistan

Oh, is it! Can you please brief me about the same, whether I am eligible to acquire such property or not?



The FEMA Gyani

Yes,! Since you are a citizen of Bangladesh residing in India and hold long-term visa granted by central government so you can acquire one immovable property for residential purpose and one for self-employment purpose. But for this you need to comply with various conditions, let me brief you about the same.

The property shall not be located in and around restricted or protected areas so notified by the Central **Government** and cantonment areas.

Registration documents of the property shall mention the nationality and the fact that such person is on LTV



The FEMA Gyani

The Conditions are:

The person submits a declaration to the **Revenue Authority** of the district where the property is located, specifying the source of funds and that he or she is residing in India on LTV.

the property of such person may be attached or confiscated in the event of his or her indulgence in anti-India activities.


Copy of the documents of the purchased property shall be submitted to the **Deputy Commissioner of Police or Foreigners Registration Office or Foreigners Regional Registration Office** concerned and to the Ministry of Home Affairs (Foreigners Division)


After acquiring citizenship of India you can easily sell the property
